SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN & YOUTH BILL

HOUSE **285**

An Act amending Titles 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in proceedings prior to petition to adopt, further providing for grounds for involuntary termination; and, in juvenile matters, further providing for disposition of dependent child. (Representatives KRAJEWSKI, KINSEY, CONKLIN and others) – Children & Youth, March 27, 2024

This bill provides for grounds for involuntary termination in juvenile matters.

SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILL

HOUSE 1743

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school directors, further providing for school director training programs. (Representatives MADDEN, PROBST, HILL-EVANS and others) - Education, May 8, 2024

This bill enhances and makes more efficient the training of elected school board officials.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HEALTH BILL

HOUSE 1657

An Act amending the act of June 13, 2008 (P.L.182, No.27), known as the Clean Indoor Air Act, further providing for title of act, for definitions, for prohibition, for signage, for enforcement, for preemption of local ordinances and for repeal; and making editorial changes. (Representatives FRANKEL, RABB, D. WILLIAMS and others) – Health, April 17, 2024

This bill protects Pennsylvania's workers, patrons and clients from secondhand smoke by closing loopholes in the Clean Indoor Air Act.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HUMAN SERVICES BILL

HOUSE

37 2823

An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for maternal and newborn supply kit; and establishing the Maternal and Newborn Supply Kit Fund. (Representatives MAYES, CURRY, ISAACSON and others) - Human Services, May 20, 2024

This bill establishes the Maternal and Newborn and Supply Kit Program under the Department of Health.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

HOUSE **1806**

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in public assistance, further providing for false statements, investigations and penalty; and imposing penalties. (Representatives MAYES, D. MILLER, MADDEN and others) – Judiciary, April 17, 2024

This bill increases the grading thresholds for welfare fraud to allow the Office of Inspector General to pursue a greater number of cases at the Magisterial District Justice level.

SENATE 1018 1275

An Act amending Title 2 (Administrative Law and Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in practice and procedure, providing for child victims and witnesses. (Senators KEARNEY, FONTANA, TARTAGLIONE and others) – Judiciary, May 20, 2024

This bill extends the protections provided to child witnesses during civil and criminal proceedings to administrative proceedings before the Department of Human Services.

SECOND CONSIDERATION PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE BILL

HOUSE 2220 2956

An Act amending the act of July 10, 1990 (P.L.404, No.98), known as the Real Estate Appraisers Certification Act, further providing for application and qualifications. (Representatives GUZMAN, GIRAL, HILL-EVANS and others) - Professional Licensure, May 20, 2024

This bill allows real estate appraiser trainees to work with multiple supervisors and lowers the years of experience required for appraiser supervisors.

SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILL

HOUSE 478 3051

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in other required equipment, further providing for restraint systems. (Representatives McANDREW, D. MILLER, RABB and others) – Transportation, May 20, 2024

This bill provides for restraint systems.

THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 1371 2788

An Act providing for duties of certifying officials and certifying agencies regarding the processing of certification form petitions. (Representatives HOHENSTEIN, MIHALEK, BURGOS and others) - Appropriations, March 26, 2024 Fiscal-Note Attached

This bill provides certifying agencies with clarity and consistency for providing nonimmigrant victims with documentation to use when applying for a U Visa.

THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE TRANSPORTATION BILL

SENATE 656

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for definitions; in liquid fuels and fuels tax, further providing for definitions and for imposition of tax, exemptions and deductions and providing for electric vehicle road user charge; and imposing AND (Senators ROTHMAN, DUSH. penalty. WARD) - Appropriations, April 2024 Fiscal-Note 10, **Attached**

This bill imposes an annual fee of \$290 per year on certain noncommercial passenger electric vehicles and provides for the Alternative Fuels Tax on Electricity.
